There were 277 deaths reported to the coroner. Of those reported, 131 cases were eventually referred to an attending physician because they did not meet the definition of a coroner case. Of those 131 deaths referrals, 7 required on-the-scene investigation before a determination could be rendered. One Hundred Forty-Six (146) cases became coroner cases as defined by the Ohio Revised Code.
