There were 322 deaths reported to the coroner. Of those reported, 157 cases were eventually referred to an attending physician because they did not meet the definition of a coroner case. Of those 157 deaths referrals, 7 required on-the-scene investigation before a determination could be rendered. One Hundred Sixty-Five (165) cases became coroner cases as defined by the Ohio Revised Code.
