There were 343 deaths reported to the coroner. Of those reported, 164 cases were eventually referred to an attending physician because they did not meet the definition of a coroner case. Of those 164 death referrals, (18) required on-the-scene investigation before a determination could be rendered. One Hundred Seventy-nine (179) cases became coroner cases as defined by the Ohio Revised Code.
